Guard of Honour and Dismissal

Another tradition involving our Year 6 and leaving students and staff is the Guard of Honour provided by the entire school to farewell those leaving our school community. This will also take place on Tuesday 14th December.

This year to adhere to current Covid-safe requirements, we need to be particularly careful and maintain the children in their designated cohorts and keep the required social distances. The students from Kinder to Year 5 will start gathering in grade groups in designated places from 2:15pm, to begin the guard of honour at approximately 2:25pm to allow for the normal K-2 dismissal from 2:30pm.

Year 6 parents wishing to witness the Guard of Honour before their child finishes their schooling at St. Patrick's are welcome to attend at school from designated areas (basketball court or area between the office and hall). Doing this will reduce the risk of parents mingling in a smaller space outside the school while parents of K-2 are waiting for end of day dismissal. I ask that only parents of Year 6 students attend, remain socially distant in one of the designated areas and follow the usual Covid-safe requirements. After the Guard of Honour, I also ask that Year 6 parents avoid mingling, wait for their child to come to them after the Guard of Honour has finished and then leave the school site in a timely way.

Friday 28 January is allocated for Staff Development Day with Monday 31st assigned as a day for MAI assessments for Years 3-6. The booking process for MAIs (Mathematics Assessment Interviews) through COMPASS will be provided soon. Please keep a look out for this information.

The first day for **Years 1-6 is Tuesday 1**st **February.** Kinder commence on **Wednesday 2 February** following the allocated days (31st January and 1st February) for Best Start Assessments.
