This year our school will once again be participating in the Wakakirri Story-Dance Festival. Unfortunately, the event was cancelled last year due to COVID-19. The Aboriginal word Wakakirri means 'to dance a story' according to the Wangaaypuwan people from Cobar NSW. Wakakirri provides schools with a creative arts education program to develop student creativity, engagement and wellbeing through the sharing of stories and participation in the performing arts.

As a first-time entrant the school qualifies for extra support and will have the benefit of weekly input from a qualified dance instructor from Wakakirri. The children from Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 who are participating in this event will be preparing from next week with our first rehearsals. It promises to be a wonderful experience for the children and we wish them every success with this initiative.
