PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the 2021 school year. I trust that everyone has had a wonderful holiday break and are ready for the year ahead. - Thank you everyone for supporting the Best Start and Mathematics Assessment Interviews this week, they have progressed smoothly. The information gathered by the teachers from the MAI is invaluable in getting to know your child's level of competence in counting, place value and the four number operations. The Best Start assessment provides information about the children's literacy knowledge and skills. Time will be allocated in the coming weeks for students who are still to complete the assessments.
- We look forward to seeing students in Years 1-6 on Friday 29th January dressed smartly in school uniform (Year 5 & 6 in Sports Uniform), while Kinder will commence on Monday 1st February. Once our new Kinder students are settled into their class their parents are invited to gather for 'a cuppa and a chat' at school to celebrate their successful start to big school followed by a brief meeting to answer any questions around routines and expectations. Thank you to the Parent Welcoming Committee for supporting this initiative.
- Swimming Carnival/Infants Water Fun Day Friday 5th February. All children from Years 3-6 will attend the Carnival along with any 8-year-old children from Year 2 who are capable 50m swimmers.
