PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Dear Parents and Carers, Girls and Boys,

It was fantastic to see over 30 parents attend the P&F Meeting last night. I thank parents who were able to attend for showing their strong interest and support for the school through the P&F. When we are able, we seek to provide some parent education opportunities at these meetings so that parents are up to date with new initiatives including changes in education. Last night Mrs Huggins outlined some of the changes that have occurred with school reporting. Mrs Huggins will be providing a summary of what was presented to all parents before the Semester 1 Reports are made available at the end of the term.

As you are aware, our teachers are currently busy writing reports for each child for Semester 1. We hope to have these available through COMPASS by the end of Week 9. I strongly urge all parents to have a conversation with their children about the report, both the 'achievement' but importantly also their 'effort'. I thank our teachers who have worked long hours to prepare the reports for parents. Enrolments 2025

I am continuing to hold interviews with parents and their children who have applied for an enrolment at St. Patrick's for Kinder 2025. We have a good number of applicants with enough numbers to have one class and well on the way to a second Kinder class for next year. I encourage existing parents who know of families with children ready to begin school next year, to recommend our school as the place to be. We also have places available in other grades for older students.

Building Update

Next week we will be moving our Kindergarten classes into their new rooms. We will also be relocating our Year 3 and Year 4 class groups into the library spaces so that the next stage of the refurbishment can begin. The teachers have been packing up resources ready for the big move and over the coming days resources and furniture will be taken to these spaces.

The next stage of the building project will include the building of a new lift for Block C and resurfacing this area with new synthetic grass. While this work is carried out the grass area between the School Hall and Block C will be fenced off and the bottom gate will not be accessible. As a result, our afternoon dismissal will be impacted with all buses and drive through pick up needing to leave via the double gates at the front of the school.

In the coming days, I will communicate an updated afternoon dismissal plan which we will put into action before the end of the term. I thank parents in advance for your patience, understanding and cooperation with this matter.
